



# 2015 Walk a Mile Art Show - Call to Artists!

On September 17th, hundreds of people will parade down North Street in Elizabeth Freeman Center's 5th annual Walk a Mile Men's March to Stop Rape, Sexual Assault, and Gender Violence.

### Criteria:

1. Artists may enter one or more pair of shoes.
2. Shoes must be new and never worn. Women's size 6-10 and men's 8-12 preferred.
3. Shoes should be wearable.
