

# How to: Start a Rise Together Peer-to-peer Fundraiser

### 1. Go to the Rise Together campaign page.

- b. Click "Start a Fundraiser" (under the main photo and progress bar)



- a. Join a team: Sign up to raise money as a group. In addition to a team page and goal tracking the group's collective progress, each team member will have their own fundraising page and goal.

  Groups will be listed in the Teams rankings on the main page, and individual members will be included on the Fundraisers leaderboard.
- To join an existing team, go to step 4.
- b. To create your own team, go to step 5.


Fundraise on your own: Sign up as an individual to create your own fundraising page. Solo fundraisers will display only on the Fundraisers leaderboard.

• To join as an individual, go to step 6.


### 3. Join A Team




a. On the "Choose a Fundraising Option" page, select "Join A Team"



b. On the "Find Your Team" screen, start typing the name of the team you would like to join or scroll the page for available teams. When you find the correct team, click "Join Team" below the team info.



c. If you can't find the team you're looking for, ask a team member to send you the link to the team fundraising page. Click the "Join Team" button at the top left.




d. Create your Give Lively account. You will need to provide a first and last name (you will be able to choose the name that is displayed on your public page later on), a valid email address, and a password. Give Lively will send you a confirmation email to activate your account. If you have not received it in a few minutes, check your spam folder.

If you have already created a Give Lively account for another campaign, even if it wasn't with EFC, you can skip this step and simply log in instead by clicking "log in to an existing account" at the bottom of the page.

e. Set up and share your personal donation page. (See step 7.)




- a. On the "Choose a Fundraising Option" page, select "Create A Team"
- b. Create your Give Lively account. You will need to provide a first and last name (you will be able to choose the name that is displayed on your public page later on), a valid email address, and a password. Give Lively will send you a confirmation email to activate your account. If you have not received it in a few minutes, check your spam folder.

If you have already created a Give Lively account for another campaign, even if it wasn't with EFC, you can skip this step and simply log in instead by clicking "log in to an existing account" at the bottom of the page.

- c. Give your team a name. This can't be changed once you receive your first donation or add your first teammate, so make sure it's clear and easy to remember.
- d. On the Congrats page, click the second option to set up your Team Page.



- e. From this page, you can
- Finalize your team name
- Add a description
- Set a group fundraising goal, as well as a suggested goal for individual members. (Members can change their fundraising goal when they register.)
- Add a team logo or icon (this will show on the Leaderboard) and a hero image or video.
- Set an accent color for your page.




- f. From your Team Page, you can
  - Write an update on your campaign. You can choose to make this public or only visible to team members, and also send the update via email.
  - Edit Team Page details
  - Remove team members
  - Make a donation to the team (not credited to an individual)
  - Make a donation to a team member (will be credited to their total as well as the group total)
  - Share the Team Page via link or social media post.
- g. To set up and share your personal page, click your icon under "Team Members", then "Edit Page" at the top right. Then, go to step 7.

#### 5. Fundraise as an individual

- a. On the "Choose a Fundraising Option" page, select "Create My Own Page"
- b. Create your Give Lively account. You will need to provide a first and last name (you will be able to choose the name that is displayed on your public page later on), a valid email address, and a password. Give Lively will send you a confirmation email to activate your account. If you have not received it in a few minutes, check your spam folder.


